It has been brought to our attention that residents and their visitors have been double parking and blocking in other cars and service areas. These offenses are considered to be safety issues. Please keep in mind the following when parking in the Winbrook Parking Lots.

- **One car per space.** The vehicle registered with WPHA to that space is the only vehicle allowed to park in that space.
- Visiting guests may **not** park on WPHA property. The City of White Plains has ample street parking, parking garages and lots for visitors.
- Park in your assigned space only.
- **Vehicles can be ticketed by the White Plains Police Department, booted or towed if any of these rules are violated:**
 - Vehicle is abandoned, inoperable, without NYS License plates.
 - Parked in an unauthorized or illegal space.
 - Blocking Emergency Vehicle Access lanes
 - Blocking fire hydrants
 - Handicapped Spaces
 - Blocking entrances, driveways, and walkways
 - Parked in another Resident's Space.
 - Parked in Employee or Staff spaces, or areas.
 - Parked in Service Areas
 - Blocking Trash Dumpsters or Fuel Delivery areas
 - Hindering Snow Removal
 - Blocking WPHA Maintenance Access & Work Areas.
 - **Double Parking in a space.**
 - **Blocking another Resident's Space.**

Violation of parking rules will result in parking privileges being revoked.
